Church Talk for March for Life UK/LifeFest 20

Hello/Hi, I'm speaking here today to invite you to attend March for Life UK on Saturday 13th June in London. 10 years ago the Equality Act was passed in the UK. This replaced the Disability Act which was passed in 1995, yet a decade later, in a so-called civilised nation, we still don't have the most basic rights for the most vulnerable human beings, in fact they are not even recognised as human beings. In 2020, unborn human beings still don't have a right to life although science tells us unequivocally that human life starts at conception. That's why our theme for this year is 'Equal From Day One'. We're human from day one so we're equal from day one.

If you've never attended a March for Life before then here's what to expect: (To be read out at Catholic churches: To begin with there is a 9am Mass available at the local Sacred Heart Church celebrated by one of the bishops who are attending). The morning part of the day is held indoors at the Emmanuel Centre and is called 'LifeFest20'. It runs from 10.30am – 1pm with pro-life stalls, children's sections aged 0-5, 5-12 and 12-17, a prayer room, an abortion reality room, live music and some of the best pro-life speakers in the world.

After the morning festival we move on to the key part of the day – the march! We will have a joy filled 'march' or procession through the heart of London proclaiming our central message of 'Life from conception – No exception' before coming to a standstill for a time of public, quiet reflection and our keynote speakers.
